### 1. Minutes and Actions from 24 April meeting

### 2. Safety

Committee agreed that we should proceed with an AIB online account with related charges of 250 pa approx.. as there is too much administration and attendant risk running the account in the current manner. The related charges are small in the context of the size of the club and its finances.

#### 6. Overseas Cycle Trip

Agreed the non-refundable deposit should be higher to reduce chances and attendant hassle of people withdrawing at short notice.
